If you audition for *JUNIE B. JONES*, **YOU MUST SIGN UP FOR A TIME SLOT**. Signups will be conducted through a sign-up genius that is available on our website in 10 minute increments (www.goshentheatreproject.org).

Casting ages range from 4<sup>th</sup> grade to 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Maximum age being 15. It's understood that ages may vary within these grade levels. Please contact us with any questions.

## SCHEDULE INFORMATION

Auditions will be held at GTP headquarters 114 West Main Street, Collinsville IL.

Saturday, January 4 and Sunday, January 5. In case of in climate weather, auditions can be performed via Zoom or Facetime with prior arrangements. Performers will be contacted for casting by Wednesday, January 8. Rehearsals will be scheduled Fridays from 6:00 -8:00pm and Saturdays from 10:00am-3:00pm. Thursdays will be added February 6 and 13 from 7:00-8:30pm until the final tech week. Specific time for tech week will be given as we get further into the schedule.

\*Rehearsals will begin on Friday, January 10, 6:00-8:00 pm. There will be a mandatory parent meeting following rehearsal 8-8:30.

#### **AUDITION INFORMATION**

We are casting 25 actors in this show. There are very specific roles to fill in *JUNIE B. JONES*, character age ranges from 6-7 to adult, ages 30-40. Please consider what fits you best as you prepare for auditions. Performers should prepare a 32 measure song that fits the genre of the show. Fun, positive and shows off the students' voice. Monologues should consist of 30-60 seconds of a comedic piece. Make sure your monologue fits the genre of *JUNIE B.JONES* 

and the character you are auditioning for. Do your research of the show. It will show up in your audition! Dancing, gymnastics and cheerleading skills are a plus. We ask that you bring in your own device with an accompaniment to keep things moving smoothly. An accompanist will be available but a Capella would also be wonderful to hear your voice shine!

## **DETAILS**

There is a participation fee for *JUNIE B. JONES* which is due on or before the first rehearsal. The fees cover the cost of professional staff, show shirt, and costuming. The Goshen Theatre Project is committed to providing access to the production for all participants. If the participation fee is a hardship, the performer may apply for a Production Scholarship. The Goshen Theatre Project would like to afford every person the opportunity to experience theatre. THIS FORM MUST BE TURNED IN WITH OTHER FORMS AT THE TIME OF AUDITIONS.

Fees are as follows:

- Production fee \$150.00 (Includes performer t-shirt, scripts, and most costume materials)
- Additional Shirt fee (for family members) \$20.00

Also remember, while we value all talent that try out for our productions, we do not have enough roles for every performer to be chosen. Please explain this to your performer and feel free to contact us with any questions or concerns. We look forward to working with you!

IMPORTANT REMINDER: In order to make this production a success, we ask that parents give 3 hours of their time per performer to help with this show.
